Parochial CCD Center Planned for Anacortes

Anacortes-Parkhurst and Lange Co., has been awarded the contract for St. Mary's CCD Center. Anacortes, according to an announcement made at the Chancery Office. Their basic bid was \$299,900.

Other basic bids were as follows: Eiford-Sather-Harmon, \$306,600; Bustad, Inc., \$311,900; Beauchamp, \$340,192.

St. Mary's 12-Acre site will also plan for a future convent across from the CCD center.

Fr. Paul Auer is Pastor of St. Mary's Parish.

Plan for the new school includes eight classrooms of masonry structure and an area of 21,000 square feet. The exterior walls are eight-inch brick block units, insulated with vermiculite, while the interior walls are six-inch block units. All walls are of exposed masonry. The roof is of modified gables and the building includes a large kitchen. The building is designed for additions of up to eight classrooms.
